1. The West and Central African Council for Agricultural Research and Development (CORAF/WECARD) has benefited from a subvention provided by IDRC to cover the costs for the establishment of a *Platform for exchange between researchers and policy makers for adaptation to climate change in Africa*. CORAF/WECARD's intention is to use part of this subvention to pay for the services of an international or national consultant to facilitate a series of workshops on Sensitization on the platform for exchange between researchers and policy makers for adaptation to climate change in Africa
2. The Objective of the Facilitation is: *the perception and understanding of participants in the sub regions (East, Central, Southern and North Africa) on how to effectively participate in implementing the project improved.*
3. The consultant will be expected to deliver the following outputs: *Key stakeholders in adaptation to climate change in each of the above regions are informed about details of the project and key partners for implementing the project in each sub region are identified*
4. In order to deliver these outputs, the consultant will ensure that the following activities are carried out in each of the sub regions:
 - a) Familiarising participants with the project document;
 - b) Preparing materials for, and facilitating a 2-day Workshop;

- c) Preparing a workshop report for each of the workshops.
5. The Executive Director of CORAF/WECARD invites individual international or national consultants to express their interest in providing the services described above. Consultants should indicate the particular workshop(s) of interest for facilitation.
 6. Consultants interested in this call must provide information justifying their capacity to implement the said services. This will include methodologies, brochures, references concerning the execution of similar contracts, CV, experience in similar areas, availability, etc.
 7. The consultants will be selected according to procedures defined in the *Guide: selection and employment of consultants by the lenders of the World Bank*, revised edition of May, 2004, October, 2006, May 2010 and January 2011
